Designed for students entering grades 6 through 8, this two-week summer camp will be an engaging program that teaches campers the basics of singing, songwriting, instrumental performance, production / beatmaking, dancing / choreography, and more. Students will learn the power of music while seeing firsthand that there is room for everyone in the arts. They will have the opportunity to collaborate with other campers and be exposed to the tools needed for them to find their own creative SPARK!

June 21, 2019. Applications will be considered on a first come, first serve basis. Early submission is encouraged, as our camps fill up quickly!

The camp will incorporate workshops and experiences designed to cultivate talent, expose students to different musical genres and cultures, teach lessons in teamwork and collaboration, encourage creativity and self expression, and develop comfort and confidence in a performance setting. Some of the exciting activities will include students making their own instruments, drum circle sessions, songwriting and lyric composition, and teambuilding games. Campers will come and spend two weeks of their summer with the Motown family, learn from the Motown model and spark their creativity! Parents/Guardians must return the application and submit the \$20 application fee and scan/copy of student's most recent school report card via one of the following methods:
